- Real Property reassessment notices have been mailed. The City only mails notices to property owners where the assessment has changed since July 1, 2015. This year, notices have been sent to 578 property owners. The appeal period ends at 5 p.m. August 8, 2016. Detailed information regarding the Appeal process on the assessment notice.
