

The Lynchburg Planning Commission will hold a public hearing for citizen comment on July 11, 2018 at 4:00 p.m., in the Conference Room, second floor, City Hall, 900 Church Street, on the following matters:

Petition of Todd DeCourcy, Thomas Road Baptist to rezone approximately twenty three hundredths (.23) acres at 4259 White Street from R-2, Low-Medium Density Residential to R-3, Medium Density Residential to allow the use of an existing structure as a duplex.

Petition of the City of Lynchburg to adopt the Graves Mill Corridor Improvement Study as part of the City's *Comprehensive Plan 2013-2030*. The study recommends improvements to traffic operations, safety, and multimodal elements, including measures such as additional turn lanes, adaptive and coordinated signal controls, and a multi-use path. The plan also recommends a roundabout at the intersection of McConville Road & Graves Mill Road and a diverging diamond interchange along the Graves Mill Road/US 501 Expressway Bridge.

City Council is tentatively scheduled to hear the petition(s) on August 14, 2018 at 7:30 p.m., in City Council Chamber, first floor, City Hall, 900 Church Street.
