Notice of Public Meeting
Regarding
Fiscal Year (FY) 2017, Program Year 2016 Community
Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Program**

A meeting of the Community Development Advisory Committee (CDAC) is rescheduled for Thursday, March 3, 2016 at 11:00 a.m. in the Second Floor Training Room of City Hall, 900 Church Street.

The purpose of this meeting is to review submitted CDBG and HOME Program applications for FY 2017 (Program Year 2016) and formulate recommendations for consideration by City Council regarding the allocation of approximately \$775,500 in CDBG entitlement, program income and reprogrammable funds and approximately \$305,985 in HOME Program entitlement funds.

The City started the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Program Annual Action Plan process through a City Council public hearing to review and update the adopted 2015-2020 Five Year Consolidated Plan goals on January 12, 2016. The primary objectives of the CDBG Program are to provide for activities that benefit low and moderate-income persons, aid in the elimination of slums and blight, and meet urgent community needs. The purpose of the HOME Program is to expand the supply of decent, safe, sanitary and affordable housing.

Reasonable efforts will be made to accommodate non-English speaking persons who wish to speak. Likewise, the City will make reasonable efforts to accommodate persons with disabilities.
