NATURE CODES (that officers may self-initiate on, if there are no officer safety concerns)

- **Abandoned Vehicle**
- **Advice** – a non-emergency request for information
- **Barking Dog**
- **Building Check**
- **Community Policing**
- **Directed Patrol**
- **Directed Patrol Traffic** – related to traffic enforcement
- **Directed Patrol Vehicle** – officer remains in his/her vehicle
- **Directed Patrol Walking** – officer conducting foot patrol
- **Disabled Vehicle**
- **Dog at Large** – not on leash or under voice control of responsible party
- **Escorts** – having another vehicle follow you somewhere (not giving someone a ride)
- **Follow-up Investigation**
- **Found Property**
- **Give Assistance**
- **Hazardous Material Inspection**
- **Hazards** – any type of roadway obstruction
- **Miscellaneous**
- **Motor Carrier Inspection**
- **Neighborhood Watch**
- **Parking Violation**
- **Property Damage/Vandalism**
- **Unlock Vehicle**

DISPOSITION CODES

- **AM – Arrest Made** – a custodial or non-custodial arrest where no report is done
- **FA – False Alarm** – an alarm that was not caused by criminal activity
- **GA – Gone on Arrival** – an offense occurred, but the suspect left prior to your arrival
- **HO – Handled by Officer** – no arrest, no report, no summons (this includes giving advice or dealing with a civil matter)
- **RA – Report Filed & Arrest Made** – a custodial or non-custodial arrest where a report is done
- **RF – Report Filed** – report with no arrest, no summons
- **RS – Report Filed & Summons Issued** – report and summons (not a releasable arrest)
- **SU – Summons Issued** – usually traffic related (do not use for criminal offenses that are actually arrests)
- **UF – Unfounded** – the crime you responded to did not actually occur
