On August 15, 2015 at approximately 2205 hours, officers with the Lynchburg Police Department responded to 1515 13th St. in reference to a shots fired call. Upon arrival at the scene, officers located three victims who received gunshot wounds. The three victims were transported to the Lynchburg General Hospital by Lynchburg Fire and EMS. The juveniles were identified as a 16 year old male and a 17 year old male. The 16 year old victim died as a result of his injuries at the Lynchburg General Hospital and the 17 year old victim was treated and released. The third victim was identified as 21 year old Dakota Scott, of Lynchburg. Scott is currently in stable condition.

No arrests have been made at this time, however, the incident is currently under investigation by the Lynchburg Police Department's Criminal Investigations Division.
