On Wednesday, February 24, 2016 at 9:54 am, the Lynchburg Police Department along with Lynchburg Fire and EMS responded to the intersection of Campbell Ave. and Florida Ave. in reference to a motor vehicle crash involving a 1991 Buick 4 dr and a 2004 Ford truck.

The investigation has determined that the driver of the Buick, John T. Shelton 40 yoa from Farmville VA, failed to stop for a red traffic light and struck the Ford truck. The truck was being driven by Taylor M. Clark, 27 yoa from Lynchburg, VA. Both drivers were transported to the Lynchburg General Hospital by Lynchburg Fire and EMS with non-life-threatening injuries.
