On 05-25-2016 at approximately 10:43 AM, Officers with the Lynchburg Police Department's Forensics Unit, Intelligence Unit, Community Action Team, and Field Operations Division responded to 6015 Fort Avenue (Fort Hill Shopping Center). Jason F. Cordier, age 38, of Concord, VA was taken into custody in reference to an ongoing criminal investigation involving the solicitation of a minor. He was charged with five felony counts of solicitation of a minor in violation of section 18.2-370 of the Code of Virginia and one count of use of a communication system to facilitate certain offenses involving children in violation of section 18.2-374.3 of the Code of Virginia. Jason Cordier is currently being held at the Blue Ridge Regional Jail in Lynchburg with no bond.
