Changes are coming to Lynchburg's Trash Collection System

Lynchburg residents will have a revised trash system beginning Monday, April 7, 2014. The new system eliminates the trash tag and replaces it with specially marked pre-paid Lynchburg trash bags. The new 33-gallon blue bags will be available for purchase at most grocery and convenience stores in packages of five (5) for \$6.25.



Spring is here, and as temperatures warm, there is an increased danger of thunderstorms, tornados and flooding across the area. Use the warm temperatures and increased daylight to prepare your home, school and workplace for severe weather. Being prepared is as simple as Get a kit, Make a plan, and Stay informed.

- **Get a kit** – Include three days of food and water (one gallon per person per day); a battery-powered or hand-crank radio with extra batteries; and your written family emergency plan.
- **Make a plan** – With your family, write down your emergency family plan which includes an out-of-town family or friend and any medications your family members may take.
- **Stay informed** – Listen to local media for instructions from emergency officials. Stay informed about storm watches and warnings. Together we are all better prepared! For more information, visit www.ReadyVirginia.gov.



How Does the New System Work?

Residents may still purchase an annual decal for their trash cart. A decal for the 32-gallon cart is \$40 and \$80 for the 64-gallon cart. If a decal is used, the resident does not have to purchase a specially marked bag and may use a trash bag of their choice. The exception to this rule applies when there is more trash than the cart can handle and a pre-paid blue trash bag is placed outside of the cart. The specially marked 33-gallon blue bags replace trash tags and must be purchased if a trash decal is not used. The blue bags may be purchased at most grocery and convenience stores.

For children who will be 5 years old by September 30, 2014:



E. C. Glass Senior Selected For First Excellence In Science Scholarship

Lynchburg City Schools is pleased to announce that E. C. Glass High School senior, Samuel Fedeler is the recipient of the first \$25,000 Award for Excellence in Science Scholarship. Samuel attends the Central Virginia Governor's School for Science and Technology each morning and then returns to his base school of E. C. Glass where he takes four Advanced Placement courses each afternoon. He is interested in molecular physics and pursuing degrees in the fields of physics, chemistry, and computer science. He has applied to and is anxiously awaiting acceptance from universities such as MIT and Carnegie-Melon.

Each senior applicant completed a written application packet that included a letter of interest, three letters of recommendation, and an official transcript. This year, there were 19 very strong applicants. The top five applicants participated in an interview with a panel of administrators, science specialists, and community members.



The Excellence in Science Scholarship was established by the family of Dr. Charles Pryor, who donated \$100,000 to Lynchburg City Schools in support of awarding one \$25,000 scholarship each year for the next four years to a LCS high school senior who has demonstrated a strength and interest in science.
