Re: Changes to City's Manual of Specifications and Standard Details

To Engineers and Design Professionals Working in the City of Lynchburg:

On May 30, 2020, the City of Lynchburg Manual of Specifications and Standard Details, April 2020 edition became effective. Several changes were incurred.

Please be aware that any TRC/RWS plans submitted for first review after July 1, 2020 must adhere to the new specs. Several areas of particular change include changes to the roadway patch thicknesses, trench bedding and backfill changes for most pipes, deletion of RCP pipe for sanitary sewer uses and clarification of use of polypropylene pipe and the specifications thereof.

We encourage everyone to again review the new standards and procedures to become familiar with all the changes. We have listed the changes in an attachment to this letter, which can also be found on the city's website along with the new edition of the Manual.

Please share this information with anyone else in your organization that may need to know about it.

We appreciate your attention to and incorporation of these new requirements as we all work towards a safer community. Thank you for supporting development in the City of Lynchburg.
